Irritable Bowel Syndrome (IBS)

Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD)

IBD refers to inflammation or chronic swelling

IBS is a chronic **syndrome** made up of a group of symptoms. $\bigoplus_{i \in S}$

of the intestines.Crohn's disease

Ulcerative colitis (UC)

Symptoms:

- Gas
- Bloating
- Trouble sleeping
- Constipation

Both are digestive conditions affecting esophagus, stomach and intestines and share the following symptoms:



- Abdominal pain
- Diarrhea
- Cramping
- Fatigue

Symptoms:

- Fever
- · Blood in the stool
- Anemia
- · Weight loss

Does not cause inflammation, Can cause destructive inflammation and rarely requires hospitalization/surgery permanent harm to the intestines Inflammation visible during examination No visible signs of disease or Blood and stool tests abnormality during an exam Diagnostic imaging (CT or MRI) of the colon Colonoscopy Dietary modifications Dietary modifications Medication Medication Therapy Surgery No increased risk for Increased risk for colorectal cancer or IBD colorectal cancer
